RED RIBBON CLUB (RRC) POLICY DOCUMENT

Red Ribbon Club (RRC) is a voluntary on campus intervention being implemented in the higher Educational institutions, aiming at heightening their risk perception and preventing HIV as well as promoting voluntary blood donation among youth between the age of 17-25 yrs with technical support from TANSACS. Red Ribbon Club is a movement to create and raise awareness about HIV/AIDS through service, education and events. Its aim is to equip the youth with correct information on HIV/AIDS Prevention, care, support and treatment. It intends to build their capacities as peer educators in spreading messages on positive health behaviour and increasing voluntary blood donation among youth.

Objectives of RRC

- 1. To spread awareness among the youth particularly the students about the dreaded disease HIV/AIDS.
- 2. To reduce new occurrences of HIV infection among youth by raising their risk perception through awareness on HIV prevention methods.
- 3. To induce among the youth a spirit to help and support people living with HIV/AIDS.
- 4. To promote the habit of voluntary blood donation among the youth.
- 5. Organize the free medical check -up and blood donation camps in the college campus.
- To be a platform to motivate youth and build their capacity as peer educators and help them develop their skills of leadership and team building and thereby guide them to be change makers.
- 7. To aware and counsel the students regarding their health in terms of various diseases.
- 8. To create awareness about the drug abuse and its harmful effects.
- 9. Celebrating days of importance related to health and hygiene.
